### INTRODUCTION

# **ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION**

The policies put in place by the Trump administration confronted the illegal immigration crisis and began to bring the infiltration of our southern border under control. More than a year since the start of the Biden Administration, this has all changed. In fact, illegal immigration at our southern border may be the worst it has ever been.

Figures from the US Customs and Border Protection are startling. In January, the agency reported that in 2021 "more than 2 million unauthorized migrants came across the Mexican border in the calendar year and were apprehended or turned themselves in – in addition to those not stopped or detected."

"Preliminary numbers released by ICE reveal that removals fell more than 70 percent in FY 2021," reports the Center for Immigration Studies.

# REFUND THE POLICE

The Defund the Police movement has been one of the single biggest policy failures of the Democratic Party over the past two years, costing the lives of countless police officers and civilians endangered by its absurd ideology.

FBI statistics show that murders in the United States rose 30% at the height of the BLM/Defund Movement in 2020, and rose an additional 5% in two dozen major cities in 2021. In an op-ed for Fox News, Buck Sexton, political commentator and former CIA analyst notes, "police suffered more casualties nationwide – 73 killed in the line of duty in 2021- than they have in almost three decades. Last month, 30 police officers were shot-seven so far this year in NYC alone."

## **POLICE OVERSIGHT BOARDS**

For this reason, police oversight boards will become key battlegrounds in ensuring that police can conduct their work properly.

At their worst, police oversight boards are political weapons used to investigate and obstruct police at the community level. In Willimantic, Ct, for instance, the local Civilian Review Board Study Committee voted to establish a civilian review board to investigate complaints levied against the police department.

But the Willimantic Police Chief, Paul Hussey, found that one study committee member who recommended the new oversight board claimed on social media that, "Willimantic police officers shoot African Americans for no reason."

Racial grievances are one of the primary tools used by the Left in justifying their radical anti-police policies and the above example highlights the potential subversion of police departments by political actors. We must stay vigilant against activist oversight boards and make sure that their work is conducted impartially so that police may do their jobs.
